#### Part D: Initiatives Undertaken:

#### 1. Feminine Hygiene Product Restocking:

• As part of our ongoing efforts to support girls' education and well-being, we successfully restocked two (2) partner schools with feminine hygiene products.



• A total of **880 packets** of feminine hygiene products were distributed across the two schools, ensuring that girls have access to the necessary resources for their hygiene needs once the schools reopened.

## Part E: Stakeholder Engagement Event:

- As an engagement and fundraising strategy, we commenced preparation and planning of the Stakeholder Engagement Event scheduled for 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
- The preparations involved collating a list of all stakeholders (suppliers, contractors, subcontractors, etc.) for Superior Homes Kenya.
- We also embarked on the development of Stakeholders Deductions Policy to be effected from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023. The policy will invite all stakeholders to voluntarily contribute a 1% minimum value of every invoice supplied to Superior Homes Kenya.

## Part F: Superior Homes Foundation August 2023 Budget Utilization

- The budget for August's initiatives primarily focused on restocking feminine hygiene products for two partner schools.
- We utilized a total of Kenya Shillings 54,120 for the purchase of 55 boxes of FHPs.
- The breakdown is as follows; all funds were provided by Superior Homes Kenya.

## Part G: Challenges:

- During our initiatives in August, we encountered some challenges:
- 1. At Kanaani Girls:

The guidance and counselling teacher at Kanaani Girls reported that some girls found the confidence FHPs to be too thin. They expressed a preference for the *Soft Care pad*.



As a solution we will be engaging soft care FHPs manufacturers, Sunda Kenya

2. At Athi River Secondary School:

The guidance and counselling teacher from Athi River Secondary School reported that the school had experienced some cases of early pregnancies. As a response, the school is planning a community walk to sensitize the community about the importance of allowing girls to continue with their education. She invited the Foundation to partner for this event.

As a solution We will be engaging the school on further details about the walk and how we can participate.

## Part H: Plan for the Upcoming Month of September 2023

Looking ahead;

- We are preparing for our Stakeholder Engagement Event on September 9th, 2023, at the Sundowner Hotel. This event will provide an opportunity to share our progress and explore collaborative opportunities as well inform stakeholders about the Stakeholder Deductions Policy introduction.
- Onboarding: Our proposed partner is Lake Elementaita Secondary School. Onboarding will be done within the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of September.
- We are planning to have donation drives for staff both in Greenpark and Pazuri Vipingo as well as with the Pazuri and Greenpark estate residents for the month of September.
- Restocking will also be done in Kanaani Girls High School.
