#### Part D: Sanitary Towels Donation Bin Proposal

- In January 2026, to support our mission of keeping girls in school with dignity, we propose installing sanitary pad donation bins at all Superior Homes offices, inspired by the successful model at Sarit Centre.
- The bins will provide a simple, visible way for staff, visitors, and partners to donate pads or cash (via M-Pesa). Each bin will have two compartments, one for in-kind donations and one for financial contributions, and will be placed in high-traffic areas such as reception areas.
- A basic tracking system will be used for transparency, and volunteers at each office will help oversee the bins and report monthly. All donations will support the Foundation's outreach efforts and help address menstrual hygiene needs across our spaces.
